SEZ Developmental Framework

The SEZ Developmental Framework brings together the UN Sustainable Development Goals, the Logistic Hub Initiative, and Jamaica Vision 2030 to provide an understanding of the goals that must be met in order to achieve the "unprecedented growth and development" that is so sought for Jamaica. These policies must be taken into consideration for each investment opportunity as they relate

to the overall growth of Jamaica through SEZs. All of these goals and objectives are combined in this strategy, emphasizing how accomplishing one advances the achievement of the others and the expected outcomes. The policy outlines what the authority must do to accomplish the goals as well as how SEZ entities can carry out the Developmental Framework Policy's varied objectives which encompasses all aspects of social, economic, environmental, and governmental development.

For goals to be achieved, it is imperative they are tracked and reviewed, hence the SEZ Developmental Framework highlights a tracking and scoring system for entities in order to see where and how they are helping to achieve these objectives. The SEZ Developmental Framework essentially highlights the connections between each policy, how completing one helps in fulfilling the other, and how accomplishing stated goals in the SEZ space aids Jamaica in doing so overall.
